2022 marks the 150th anniversary of the famous "Terrier" Class of steam locomotives. Two of these Victorian masterpieces are now owned* by The Terrier Trust and your support can help keep them running for decades to come.

Membership costs just £20 per annum with Life Membership available for £200 – although during Terrier 150 year, you can purchase this for £150.

Members receive occasional newsletters, an invitation to an annual members' day at the Kent & East Sussex Railway to see the locomotives in action and have the chance to become ambassadors talking to the public about the engines when they are run on the K&ESR or during visits to other heritage railways.

Above all, members have the satisfaction of knowing their support is helping keep these marvellous machines in working order for future generations to enjoy.

* Ownership of No. 3 Bodiam is split, with The Terrier Trust CIO owning 75% and the K&ESR 25%. 2678 is wholly owned by TTT.

The Trust's locomotives are No. 3 Bodiam and 2678 built in 1872 and 1880 respectively. Both have returned to service in the last year following overhauls but keeping the plucky pair in action in future is likely to require the replacement of various components which after a century-and-a-half are worn beyond repair.

The engines were designed by William Stroudley for the London, Brighton & South Coast Railway and originally worked in South and East London but as trains became faster and heavier, they were displaced by larger locomotives.

Their compact, lightweight, yet powerful design made the Terriers particularly useful and versatile and many found use on other railways with Bodiam (which as L&BSCR No. 70 Poplar, was one of the first batch to enter service) being sold to the Kent & East Sussex Railway in 1901 and 2678 seeing service on the Isle of Wight, Hayling Island Branch and the K&ESR.
